

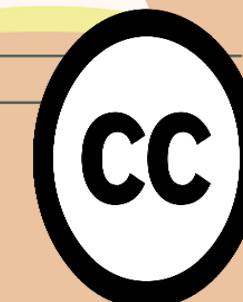


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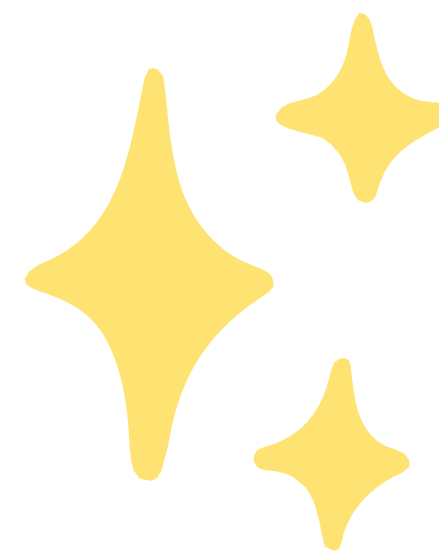

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT



Concepts can be explained by students through peer teaching activities.
